STEPS IN THE PROCESS

PRE-VISIT: The school prepares the requested documents. The SchoolWorks (SW) Team works with the school to organize the schedule for the visit. SW Team Members review documents and record initial questions.



EVIDENCE GATHERING: The SW team reviews additional documents and conducts classroom visits and interviews and/or focus groups with key school stakeholders.



DEVELOPMENT OF FINDINGS: The SW team works together to collate and discuss evidence. Findings are organized as strengths and areas to grow.



FEEDBACK: While on-site, the SW Team continually seeks input from school leadership and keeps the school informed of progress.



DEBRIEF: The SW Team facilitates an on-site debrief session with school staff to share and discuss initial findings of the review.



WRITTEN REPORT: After the visit, the school and district receive a written report that formalizes the findings discussed on site.
